Unfortunately, there is a cost involved and yes, decisions have to be made as to who we take in as it is a commitment we made to the others we already have on board that we will provide them with whatever they need, for as long as it takes. The harsh reality of rescue is that the smaller dogs are in greater demand and their adoptions provide us the assistance needed to keep the larger, less adoptable dogs due to size as well as older animals on board and provide them that safe haven, they so rightfully deserve. Thank you to each and every one of you for your monetary donations as well as donations of items so necessary to keeping our operation going. 
